One-Stop Center/WIA Orientation: The One-Stop Center/WIA Orientation will provide you with information about the Workforce Investment Act and the services available at the One-Stop Center and through community resources and partners. You will also learn about the programs, educational opportunities, tools and resources available to help you in your job search. The workshop is required if you are interested in the Workforce Investment Act Program (WIA) or need more information about the center.

ResCare Academy: ResCare Academy is a free online tool available 24/7 that uses the following resources to make job seekers more attractive to employers: ResCare GED Academy; 4000+ career enhancement courses; training for more than 100 workforce industries; Math, English, Reading and Writing enhancement courses; & professionally-respected certificates for many courses completed.

Resume Hero/Applicant Tracking Software (ATS): Using Resume Hero, a web-based resume writing tool, you will have access to suggested keywords and phrases to build a professional resume of your career goals, skills, experience and education. Job seekers will create competitive resumes from scratch that are sure to get past applicant tracking software (ATS) which many companies use to screen resumes and applications. Explore the resume from an employer's perspective, teaching to sell oneself into employment, convince employer that job seeker is the right match for the job applying for.

LinkedIn Beginner: Learn how to create a LinkedIn-Beginner account and build your professional profile. You will learn about the basic features of LinkedIn-Beginner to expand your professional networking opportunities. Provide jobs seekers with tips on how to utilize privacy settings on social networking sites to ensure a successful job search.

Persons with Disabilities & Employment: Understand the challenges that persons with disabilities face in their search for employment. The workshop assists you in understanding how to sell your abilities and reduce the focus of a disability. We provide techniques on how to squash fears and sell your skills and abilities.

Resume Hero Open Lab: For individuals who have completed a Resume Hero/ATS workshop, and would like additional support utilizing the Resume Hero web-based resume writing tool.

Transferable Skills: The concept of transferable skills is a vital job-search technique that all job-seekers should master, these are important for career changers and college students. Transferable skills are skills you have acquired during any activity in your life, virtually any skills that are transferable and applicable to what you want to do in your next job. You will take an assessment test that highlights your strengths and assess the skills you can transfer into another career.

Networking/Hidden Job Market: We will explore the local economy and its effects on job seekers. Ensure job seekers understand the need for urgency in their employment search and how to tap into the hidden job market. Emphasize the importance of using multiple methods of job search such as networking, Linked-in and contacting employers directly to secure employment.

Interview Techniques: Employment experts teach on how to overcome employer fears in an interview. How to sell yourself and show that you fit into the company culture during the interview. Using the power of language to frame the answer to a tricky question. What are hiring managers in 2015 looking for in a candidate? First impressions and body language are covered in this workshop. Feel free to sign up for a Mock interview with a consultant. (*Mock Interviews available upon request.*)

New Beginnings: It is true that a felony conviction can make it more difficult to find and secure employment; however you are not without options. You must exercise patience, persistence and honesty. In this workshop we discuss and examine changing the environment, job seeker options, completing the applications and what to say in the interview. (Available upon request.)

Professional Networking Group (PNG): Designed for seasoned professionals who are interested in taking charge of their job search by learning how to network effectively, improve job search skills, learn about the latest job search tools and have access to experts who can help you reach your career goals.
